

The elegant Olympics. Foulards from the mountains

The selection of foulards coming from the important National Mountain Museum collection celebrates sport and the Olympic spirit on the occasion of 2018 edition of Olympic and Paralympic Winter Games in PyeongChang.

About 50 foulards are exposed in white lacquered wood frames, woven in silk (some in cotton, wool or synthetic materials). You will admire those by Hermès, the only international fashion designer who created themed foulards.

Rich in colours, signs and symbolic elements, the foulards on show retrace the editions of Winter Olympic Games from Garmisch-Partenkirchen 1936 to Vancouver 2010.

The aim of the exhibition is to bring back the positive memories of the XX Turin Winter Olympics to the Piedmontese.
