

Over my eyes. Evacuation map

Since January 2014 the war against ISIS in Iraq has caused the evacuation of about a tenth of the national population. Over a million and a half Iraqis have been forced to seek refuge in the Iraqi Kurdistan region.

Evacuation map is a collective multimedia project that describes the current crisis of refugees in the Iraqi Kurdistan region. It presents fragments of Iraqis everyday reality: lives and stories of those who have lived in refugee camps for years while the war continues to devastate the nation.

Through personal stories of families who have been forced to flee, this visual documentary illustrates the greatness and importance of a humanitarian crisis often overlooked by international media.

The project is the result of the collaboration between a group of Kurdish-Iraqi photographers and a team of international writers and editors.
