

## *From war to peace 1918-2018*

This exhibition narrates the hundred years of Italian life from the end of the First World War to today, through the works of internationally renowned artists, among which Balla, Sironi, Guttuso, Picasso, Morandi and De Chirico.

We follow the evolution of their artistic expression in relationship with both the wars, conflicts and tragedies that marked this period of history, and the theme of peace and brotherhood.

One hundred years in which the taste and fashions alternated rapidly, constantly oscillating between two easily recognizable tendencies: abstraction and figuration.
