

## WORK HUNGER: WORKERS COOKING STORIES

The exhibition aims to explore the working history of the late twentieth century, analyzing the deep changes of the ways and times of the popular cuisine. New places and new practices of cooking are increasingly gaining ground, starting from the food brought from home and heated: the famous *barachin*. This sort of lunch box contains the memories and the comforting taste of home food and helps to withstand fatigue. Afterwards it gives way to the food prepared by the canteen, valuable place of sharing and socializing.

On show typical objects of the workers' table of the 50's-70's: different forms of *barachin*, in aluminium and steel, even in two compartments, a mess tin, a *cossa* or *suca* (pumpkin), traditional container to carry the fresh wine and a bicycle used to go to work.
