

## Abilitart

Abilitart is a project conceived and realized by the Artistic Anatomy School of Prof. Belgioioso of the Albertina Academy of Fine Arts. It is the result of a journey began in 2014, in which the teaching activities were enriched by seminars, workshops and athletes performances, with the aim of encouraging over 150 students involved to tackle the disability issues in sport.

From dialogue and discussion with disabled athletes on the human and artistic level, graphic works, paintings and photographs of great emotional impact were born with the desire to reveal the potential and excellence of the body despite limitation, imperfection and disharmony.

In the hall three *Prigioni* (the statues carved in marble by Michelangelo), are represented in the colours of the Paralympic logo: red (*Schiavo che si desta*), blue (*Atlante*) and green (*Schiavo giovane*).

On the main floor around thirty works are shown made with different techniques: a statue in cement carved with fabric, watercolours on paper, oil paintings on canvas, a plaster work and an ink on paper, mixed media on paper and photographs.
